2021 Women in Tech Initiative – Terms and Conditions

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible to apply for the Women in Tech Initiative, the applicant (at the time of submitting its application):

- must have a current ABN
- must be successfully accepted as a tenant after reference checks
- must self-identify as a women or non-binary

COHORT is the right place for you if you are:

- a small business, entrepreneur or startup that is looking for a collaborative space to launch or grow your idea or product
- an emerging student or entrepreneur keen to be part of a vibrant and welcoming startup community
- an interstate business looking to establish a presence in the Gold Coast
- a business that is wanting to connect with the Gold Coast Health and Knowledge Precinct partners

Ineligible Projects

The following projects are ineligible:

- Multi-level marketing activities
- Projects involving liquor, gambling, tobacco, adult services, illicit substances or involving illegal activities
- Any project that the Cohort General Manager determines is ineligible in its absolute discretion

Guidelines for Applicants

- To be considered as an eligible applicant, the application form must be completed in full
- Applicants must formally apply through the Cohort website at www.cohortspace.com.au/apply-now
- Applications open 9am AEST, 9 August 2021 and close 5pm AEST, 27 August, 2021

Successful Applicant Benefits and Obligations

- Successful applicants receive 6 months complimentary unlimited coworking space between 8:30am – 5pm, Monday – Friday from 6 September 2021 – 6 March 2022 (valued at \$2,700 + GST each)
- Successful applicants receive 3 x 1 hour mentoring sessions with a business coach
- Successful applicants receive entry into the 2021 Start Club (valued at \$360 + GST each)
- Successful applicants receive end of program business lunch with special guest
- Successful applicants receive access to COHORT partner benefits subject to individual partner eligibility requirements
- All applications received are subject to eligibility and due diligence processes including reference checks
- 3 individual applications will be selected as successful for this initiative
- Successful applicants must agree to take part in marketing activities (e.g. involvement in success stories) for the promotion of Cohort and Lumina. Marketing material may be used across digital media platforms, along with internal and external print publications and advertising campaigns
